- 1. Help your child pack and prepare on Wednesday night.
 - Clothing (see list on back of this page)
 - Food
 - Pass and \$\$ for rentals
 - Equipment
 - Early to bed
- 2. Equipment drop off
 - Begins at 6:45 on Thursday mornings
 - Boys use the boy's locker room. Girls use the girls' locker room
 - Stored in locker room cage
 - The earlier, the better

If large numbers of ski club students arrive late to school on Thursday mornings, it creates problems for our attendance and health office staff. **Bringing in ski equipment is not a legal excuse for being late to school**. Students are required to be in homeroom at 7:40 A.M. Please plan accordingly.

- 3. Have someone available for emergencies.
 - Make sure your child knows your phone # (cell #).
 - Make sure a backup # is available.
- 4. Be at Ray for pick up by <u>9:15 P.M.</u> each week.
 - DO NOT PARK in the front of the school adjacent to the sidewalk. That's where the buses pull in. You will block them.
 - PARK on the far side of the bus circle or in the side parking lot.
 - Please drive cautiously on school grounds. Kids are tired and may not be attentive.
 - Students who are picked up late may be asked to stay home the following week.
- 5. Arrange (and verify) car pools for equipment drop off and student pick up when possible.
- If you come to Labrador (and you are welcome to join in the fun) and want to drive your child home, please hand the bus chaperone a signed note saying that you are providing transportation. <u>We cannot</u> <u>allow you to transport children other than your own.</u>
