



Parents as Reading Partners (PARP) was a three-week event this fall to encourage strong reading habits among our students. Parents or caregivers were encouraged to read for at least 20 minutes each evening with their child.

Eighty-seven percent of our students participated this year, topping last year's level of 84 percent. Mrs. Sue Allen's third grade had 100 percent participation! The top class for weekly minutes was Ms. Jennette Allen's second grade with 4,196 minutes during the final week.

PARP concluded with a trivia competition at Literacy Night on Nov. 12. More than 200 children and adults gathered as Ms. Mills, Mrs. Miles and Mrs. Ancona were crowned the school's "Top Bookworms."
