CAREER ASSESSMENTS

All Baker students have access to two free career assessments through their Scoir account. Students can login into Scoir with their google ID and password or through Clever. The first is a Career Interest Assessment Match. This one is very brief and basic. However, it is a great starting point for students. The other available assessment is, Principles You. This one takes about 30-60 minutes to complete. Principles You will provide a detailed report about characteristic traits that help pair students with careers. At the end, both of these assessments will provide career information based on individual results. If appropriate, it can also provide colleges that may have their potential majors. If you have any questions, please reach out to your child's school counselor.
