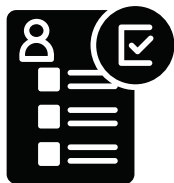
IMPORTANT UPDATES

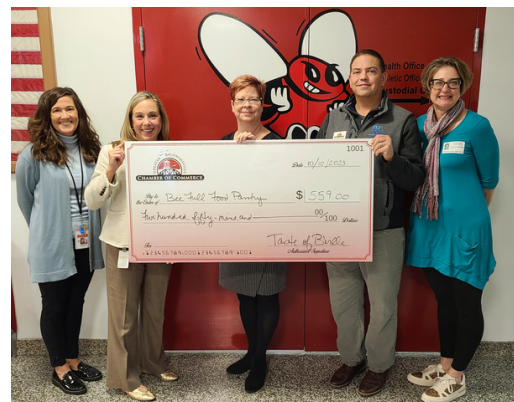
