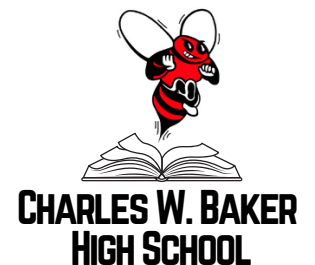

As a part of Mental Health Awareness Month, Baker High School Students will attend a presentation by **Jacob Mars**. He is a certified Suicide Prevention Instructor, sponsored by SAVE - Suicide Awareness Voices in Education. These presentations are intended to dig deeper into the mental health issues that challenge our students. There will be a continued focus on recognizing signs and symptoms of mental health issues and suicide risk factors. In addition, presentations will empower students to gain valuable knowledge, skills and resources to utilize in potential crisis situations. After each of the presentations counseling support will be available for students and staff.
