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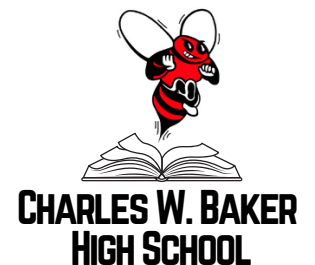

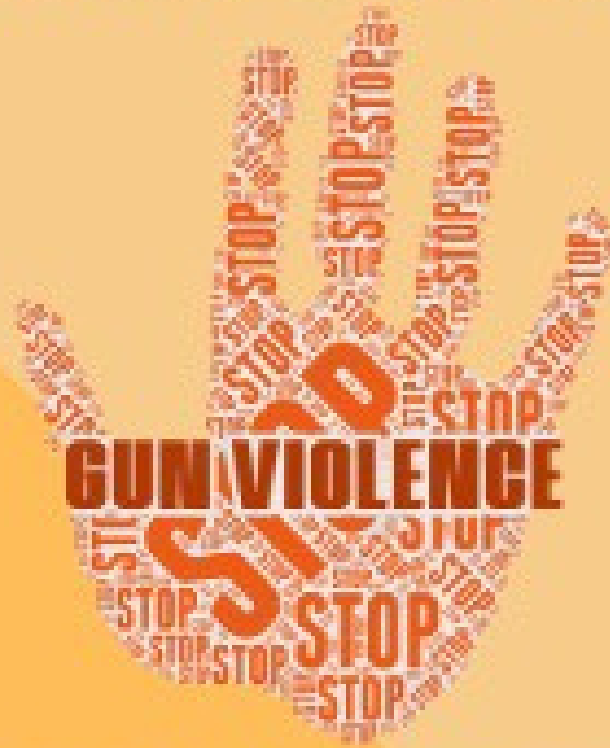

ENVIRONMENTAL GRAPHIC DESIGN

3 credits

In this course students will learn to produce 2D digital graphics and documents (posters, reports, presentations and e-docs). Content includes image processing and vector drawing; document assembly for print, viewing and electronic distribution; and general concepts of digital workflow management - all within an environmental lens.

This course will be helpful to anyone interested in graphic design and those that want to develop their skills in this area to support future academic and career endeavors. At ESF this course will specifically be valuable for those interested in landscape architecture, engineering, construction management, digital storytelling, writing and illustration, environmental interpretation, and modeling.
