

Approximately 90% of students have not had a disciplinary referral documented this year.


Attendance and Chronic Absenteeism

Students have been present over 90% of instructional days.






Enrollment trend over the last 10 years




Current enrollment by grade level





This fall, students performed better than our region on academic universal assessments.






Students scored in the typical range on each scale of social-emotional learning skills.






Suspension Counts





