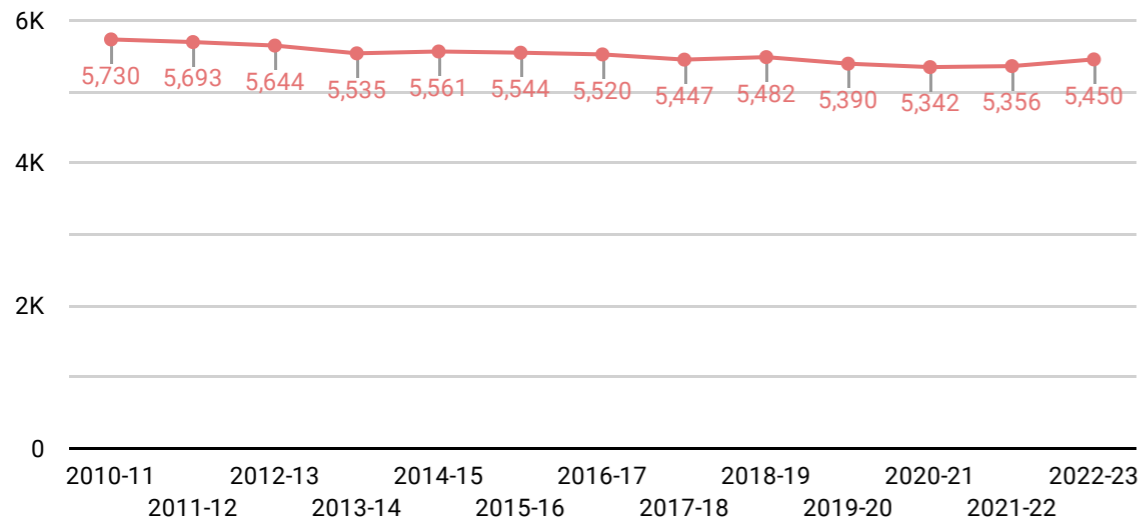
Approximately 85% of students have not had a disciplinary referral documented this year.



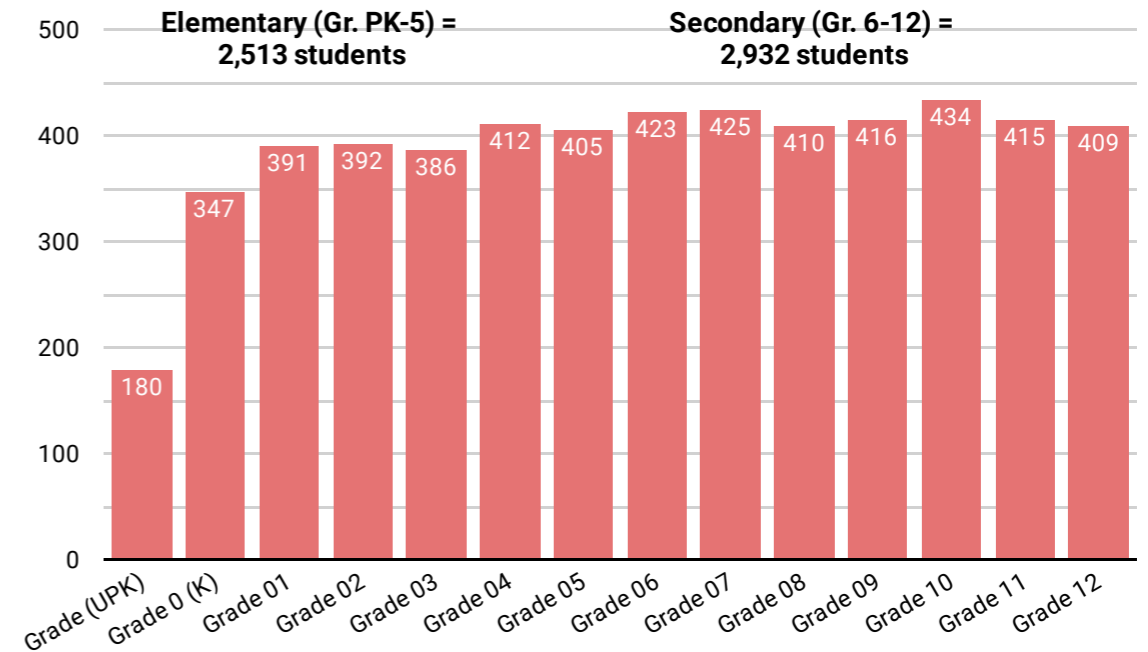
Attendance and Chronic Absenteeism

Students have been present over 90% of instructional days.

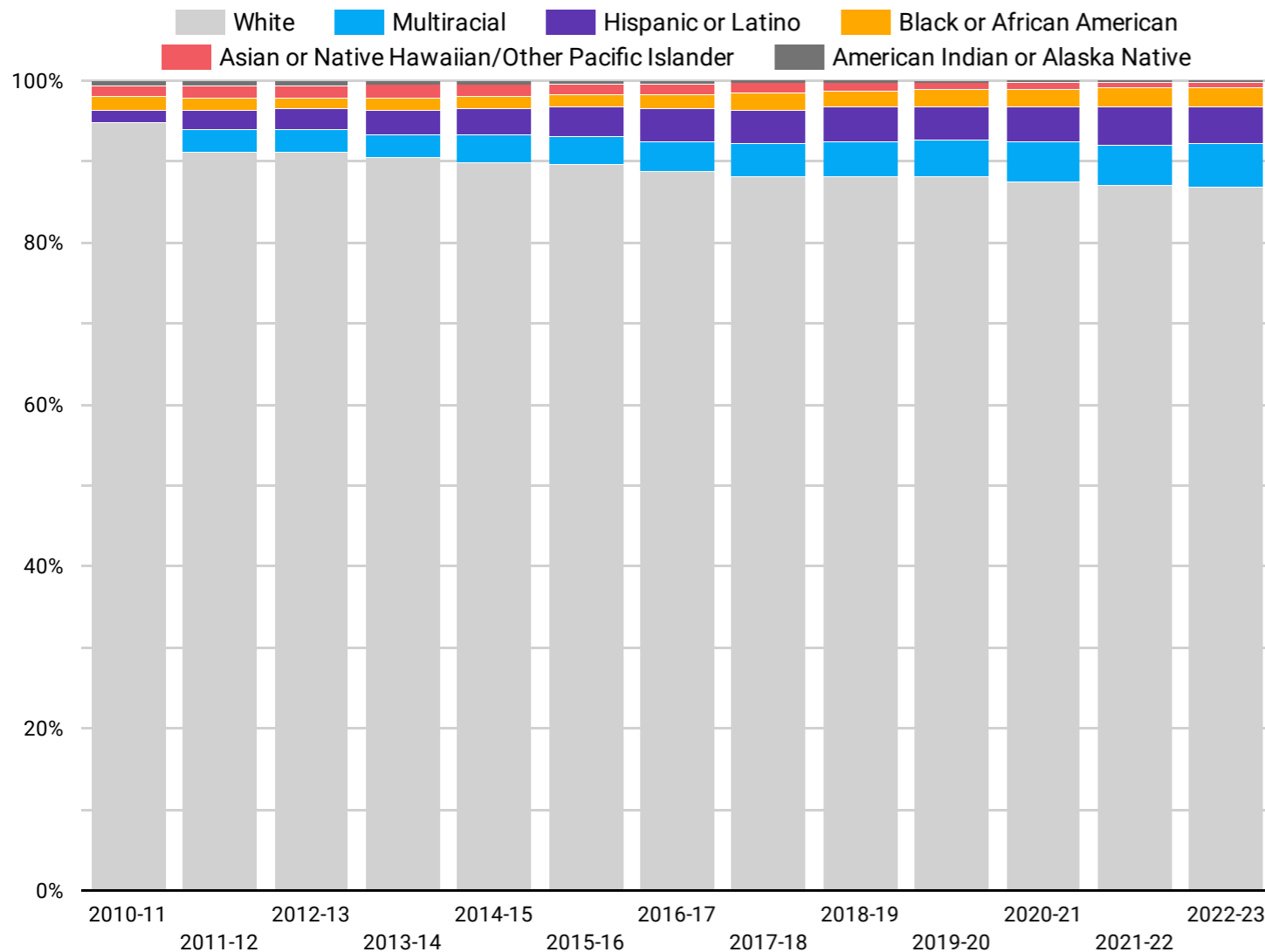
Enrollment trend over the last 10 years

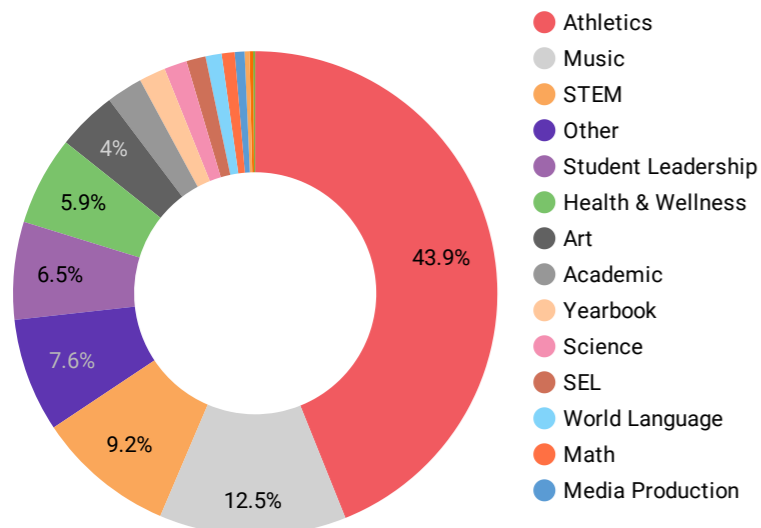
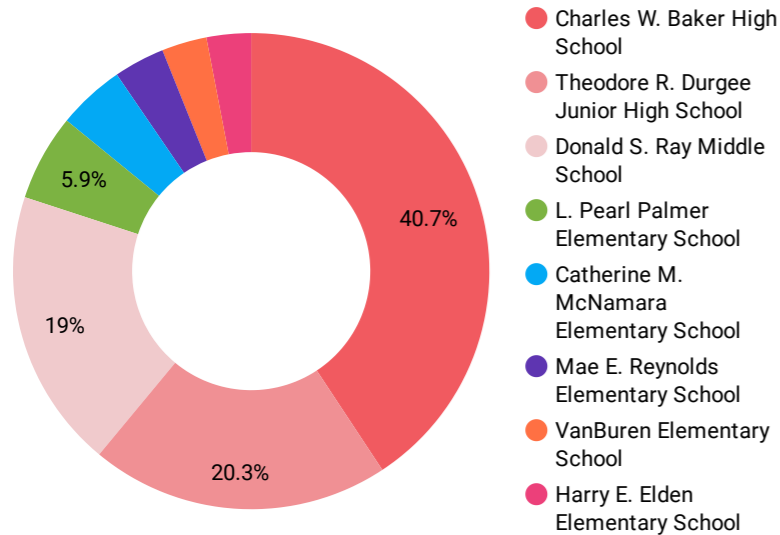

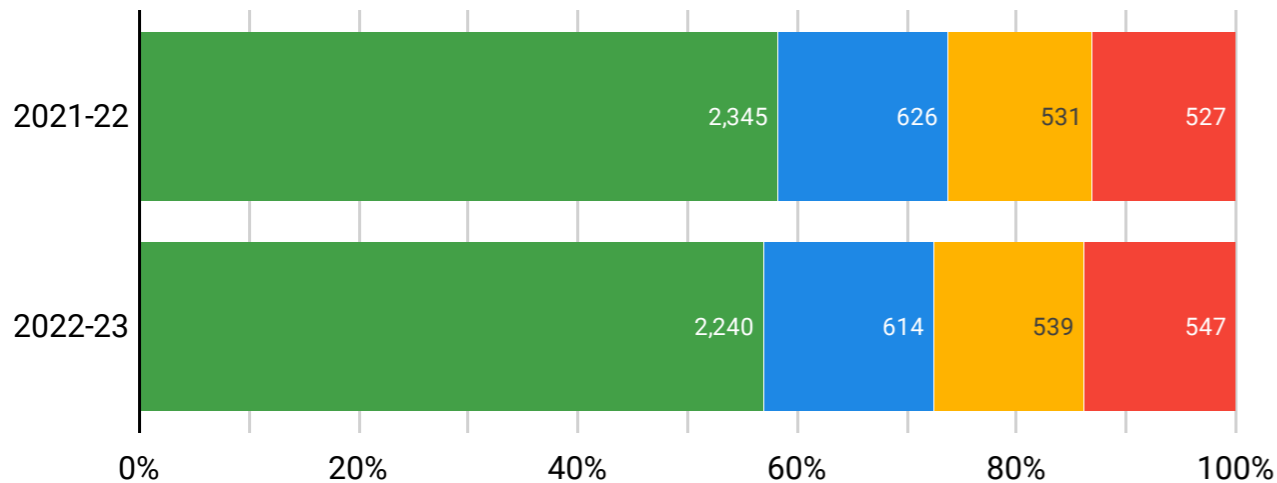

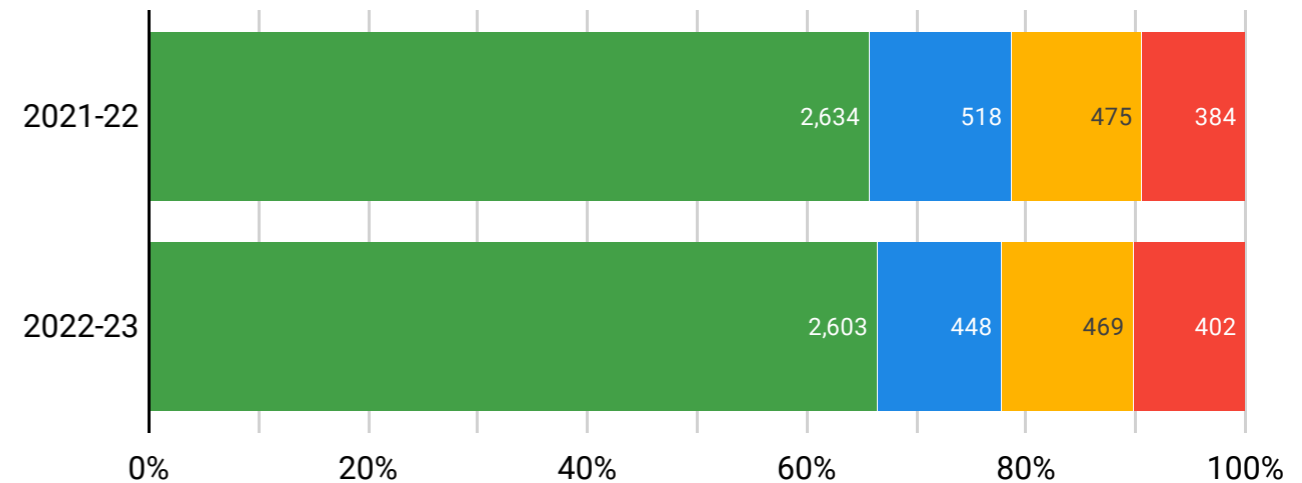

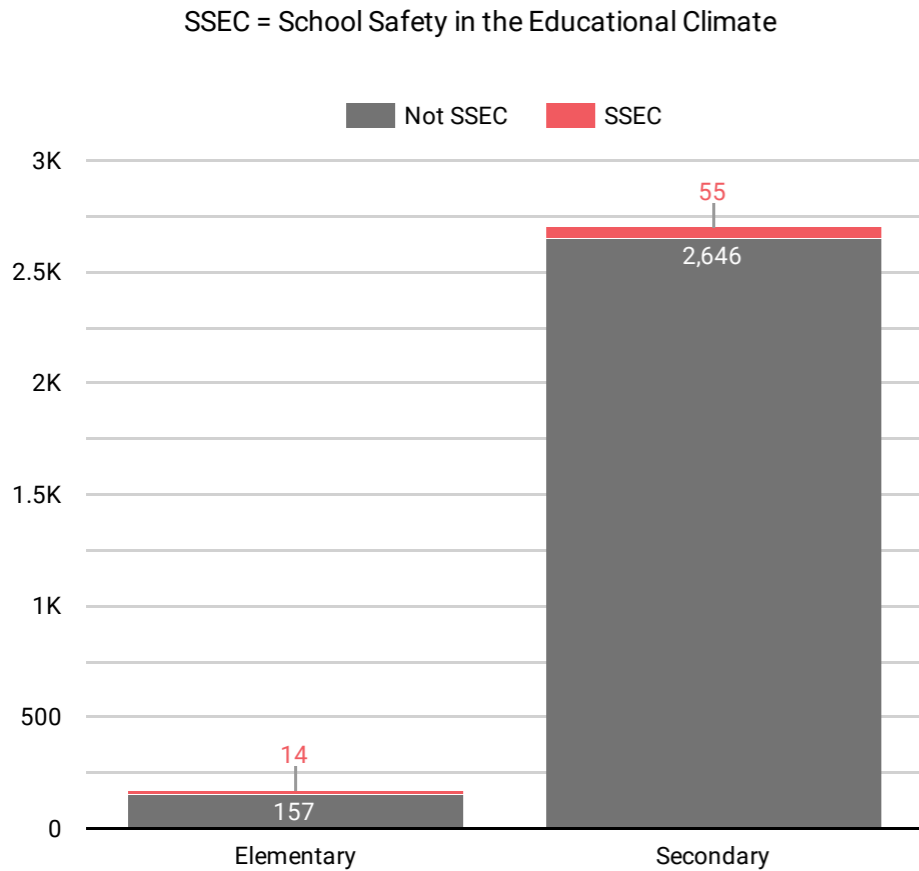
