
Approximately 80% of students did not have a disciplinary referral documented this year.




Attendance and Chronic Absenteeism

Enrollment trend over the last 10 years




Current enrollment by grade level


Our population of **students receiving free or reduced lunch** has more than doubled over the last 10 years.


