In regards to the *Dominic Murray Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA) Prevention Act*, Commissioner's Regulation 136.9 has revised the following effective 9/12/22:

A differentiation has been made between the terms "athletic activities" and "physical activities".

- **Physical activities** are defined as participation in physical education classes and recess or similar activities during the school day.
- Any student who displays signs and symptoms of pending SCA during physical
 activities must be immediately removed from such activities and cannot return until they
 receive clearance from a health care provider, which may be either a physician, nurse
 practitioner (NP), or physician assistant (PA).
- Unchanged is the requirement that any student who displays signs and symptoms of pending or increased risk of SCA during athletic activities must be immediately removed from such activities and cannot return until they receive clearance from a physician (MD or DO).
