

In regards to the *Dominic Murray Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA) Prevention Act*, Commissioner's Regulation 136.9 has revised the following effective 9/12/22:

A differentiation has been made between the terms "athletic activities" and "physical activities".

- **Physical activities** are defined as participation in physical education classes and recess or similar activities during the school day.
- Any student who displays signs and symptoms of pending SCA during **physical activities** must be immediately removed from such activities and cannot return until they receive clearance from a health care provider, which may be either a physician, nurse practitioner (NP), or physician assistant (PA).
- Unchanged is the requirement that any student who displays signs and symptoms of pending or increased risk of SCA during **athletic activities** must be immediately removed from such activities and cannot return until they receive clearance from a physician (MD or DO).
